- 1.** Was there ever a time in history when Satan was perfect in his behavior toward God?
- 2.** What two fruit trees were found in the Garden of Eden according to the book of Genesis? And, which fruit tree had fruit, which was forbidden for Adam and Eve to eat?
- 3.** Where in the Holy Bible is the very first Bible prophecy, as provided by God, which also addresses the future Millennium of King Jesus?
- 4.** In which Bible verses does King Jesus teach us, as an example in prayer, to pray, “Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven”?
- 5.** Which man in the Holy Bible was known as “the friend of God”?
- 6.** During the future Millennium of King Jesus, will many people from many nations on earth travel to Jerusalem to sit down and visit with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob?

7. Did God, in His covenant with Abraham, promise Abraham that someday Israel will be a very great nation on earth?
8. What age was Abraham when God made an everlasting covenant with him, which relates to the future Millennium of King Jesus?
9. At ninety-nine years of age, what did Abraham do when God told him his ninety-year-old wife, Sara, would have a baby?
10. Did God promise Abraham that someday, in fulfillment of Bible prophecy, the population of Israel would be “as the sand of the sea”?
11. When King Jesus builds his future Millennial Temple, how long will it exist on earth, as taught in the Holy Bible?
12. At the birth of King Jesus, what message was joyfully proclaimed from heaven by an “angel”; and, “a multitude of the heavenly host,” which were “praising God”?
13. What was the name of the 105-year-old prophetess lady in the New Testament who was a widow for 84 years; was alive when baby Jesus, Son of God, was born in Bethlehem; and, she prayed and fasted in Jerusalem’s temple, everyday looking for the peace and “redemption” of Israel from Israel’s future Messiah, King Jesus?
14. What was the name of the heavenly angel who was sent by God to tell Mary, mother of King Jesus, that she would “bring forth a son and call his name Jesus”?
15. Who made this statement in the New Testament, “But those mine enemies, which would not that I should reign over them, bring [them] hither, and slay them before me” (Luke 19:27)?
16. What Bible scripture in the Old Testament refers to King Jesus as the “Prince of Peace”?
17. What Bible scripture teaches us that all saints, which have been resurrected from the grave (called the “first resurrection”)

“shall be priests of God [our Heavenly Father] and of Christ, and shall reign with him [on earth] a thousand years” during the future Millennium of King Jesus?

18. During the one thousand-year Millennium of King Jesus, where will Satan be?
19. At the future Battle of Armageddon, when King Jesus returns to earth at is the second coming, will all of the nations/people on earth see him and all of his heavenly army as he makes his glorious appearance?
20. Does Acts 14:22 have reference to the future seven years of Great Tribulation, as described in the book of Revelation: “... we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God”?
21. In John 14:2, King Jesus spoke about his “Father’s house...with many mansions.” What was he referring to in the statement?
22. Whenever the heart of a Christian stops beating on earth and this present life on earth has ceased, will we go to heaven immediately to be with our Heavenly Father and King Jesus in the holy city, New Jerusalem?
23. In reality, do any true Christians ever die, according to the teaching of King Jesus?
24. Is it possible or probable that other gods exist in the great universe, apart from the God of Abraham [our Heavenly Father; King Jesus; and the blessed Holy Spirit]?
25. Did King Jesus teach that we could pray and ask our Heavenly Father that we will be “...accounted worthy to escape all these things [terrible events; God’s wrath; and God’s vengeance during the future seven years of Great Tribulation on earth] that shall come to pass...”
26. According to the Holy Bible, and God’s promise, will God someday, by His power, “make an end of sins” and “bring in

everlasting righteousness” as all Bible prophecy is fulfilled, as spoken by God?

27. When John, in the book of Revelation saw King Jesus in heaven, what was the color of King Jesus’s hair and his head?
28. At the future rapture of the church, will King Jesus actually be on the surface of the earth when he gathers all of his church to take them to heaven to the holy city, New Jerusalem?
29. What musical instrument will be sounded above the earth by King Jesus as he gloriously shouts loudly at the rapture of the church?
30. Following the rapture of the church, what great heavenly angel, identified as the “Great Prince,” will stand up in heaven—in preparation for the future seven years of Great Tribulation judgments and events, which will be sent by God to earth.
31. Will those Christians who meet King Jesus in the air at the rapture of the church be required to have their names written in heaven’s Lamb’s Book of Life?
32. Will God require Christians to go through the future seven years of Great Tribulation?
33. According to the Holy Bible, how quickly will the future rapture of the church event take place as all Christians meet King Jesus “in the air”?
34. In God’s plan for mankind on earth, will God someday ensure that “all things” on earth are restored to conform with his perfect will for all who live on earth?

39. When the Antichrist arises in political power and signs a peace agreement with the nation of Israel, how many years are noted in the deceptive peace agreement?
40. How many years will it take for the deceptive Antichrist to break his political seven-year peace agreement with Israel?
41. How many Great Tribulation judgments and/or events of God’s wrath and vengeance were shown to John by God in the book of Revelation?
42. Where will the Antichrist establish the religious governmental buildings “of his palace” as he seeks to be a powerful world dictator? And what will be the location of his political headquarters?
43. Will God’s “Amazing Grace” be on earth so that people can repent and become a Christian during the seven years of the Great Tribulation, following the rapture of the church?
44. Will the Holy Spirit be on earth during the future seven years of Great Tribulation to draw men and women to Christ so that they might have their names written in heaven’s Lamb’s Book of Life?

55. Can you name two Bible prophets in the Old Testament who never died because God raptured or took them up to heaven to be with him?
56. Does the Holy Bible actually teach that Enoch was a prophet of God like Elijah?
57. When God sends these two Bible prophets back to earth to preach during the future Great Tribulation, how many years will they be on earth preaching the Word of God? And what kind of clothing will they wear while they are preaching the Word of God?
58. What will happen to the two heaven-sent, Great Tribulation prophets, whom God sends to earth to preach for three and a half years, during the first half of the future Great Tribulation?
59. Will many people on earth celebrate and rejoice over the deaths of the two Bible prophets, which God will send to earth to preach his Word? And what will happen after their dead bodies lie in the street for three and a half days?
60. For everlasting, futuristic peace on earth, is it in God’s plan to “destroy them which destroy the earth” by sending his Great Tribulation judgments to earth?
61. During the last three and a half years of the future Great Tribulation, as described in the book of Revelation, will non-Jewish followers of the Antichrist control Jerusalem?

- 150.** According to King Jesus, what are the greatest things, as true repentant Christians, that we can do on earth to be accepted by God and have everlasting life, peace, and happiness in the family of God?

ANSWERS

To Bible Study Questions’ from the Word of God

1. **Yes. In Ezekiel 28:15, God speaks to Satan,** “Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that you were created, until iniquity [wickedness] was found in you.”
2. **The Tree of Life and the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil. Adam and Eve were not allowed by God to eat the fruit from the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil.** Genesis 2:9 says, “And out of the ground made the Lord God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the Tree of Life also in the midst of the garden, and the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil.” Genesis 2:16–17 says, “And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, of every tree of the Garden [of Eden] thou mayest freely eat: but of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.”
3. **Genesis 3:15. God said to Satan,** “I will put enmity [conflict] between thee and the woman [which would someday bring birth to the Son of God, King Jesus], and between thy seed

[futuristic Antichrist] and her seed [King Jesus, Son of God]; it [warfare of King Jesus] shall bruise thy head [Satan], and thou [Satan] shalt bruise his [King Jesus's] heel.”

4. **Matthew 6:9–13 or Luke 11:2–4.** The Lord’s Prayer verses of scripture.
5. **Abraham. James 2:23** says, “Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the friend of God.”
6. **Yes. In Matthew 8:11, King Jesus teaches that** “many shall come from the east and west [on Earth], and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven.”
7. **Yes. In Genesis 12:2, God says,** “And I will make of thee [Abraham] a great nation [Israel], and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing [to other nations on earth]: And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee [Abraham] shall all families [nations] of the earth be blessed [with peace].”
8. **Ninety-nine years of age. Genesis 17:1** says, “And when Abraham was ninety years old and nine [99], the Lord appeared to Abraham, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect. And I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly.”
9. **Abraham “fell on his face, and laughed.” Genesis 17:10** says, “Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart, Shall *a child* be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear [a child]?”
10. **Yes. God told Abraham in Hosea 1:10,** “Yet [someday] the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea, which cannot be measured nor numbered; and it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not

my people, there it shall be said unto them, ye are the sons of the living God.”

11. **“Forever.” In Ezekiel 37:27–28 King Jesus says,** “My tabernacle [Millennial Temple of King Jesus, Messiah of Israel] also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people. And the heathen shall know that I the Lord do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore.” [Note: This cannot be the future holy city, New Jerusalem, because it will be 1,500 miles square; therefore, by size, it could not be “in the midst of Israel.” When God does send the New Jerusalem to Earth at the conclusion of the Millennium of King Jesus, it will also be on Earth forever.]
12. **“On Earth Peace.” Luke 2:13–14 says,** “And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will [news] toward men.”
13. **Anna the Prophetess. Luke 2:36–38 says,** “And there was one Anna, a prophetess, ...she was of a great age [105], and had lived with a husband seven years from her virginity; and she was a widow of about fourscore and four [84] years, which departed not from the temple, but served God with fastings and prayers night and day. And she coming in that instant [understanding the birth of King Jesus] gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of him to all them that looked for redemption [and peace] in Jerusalem.” [If Anna was married at the age of 14; then, lived with her husband for 7 years; then, was a widow for 84 years, she would have been 105 years of age.]
14. **Gabriel. Luke 1:26 and Luke 1:30–31 says,** “The angel Gabriel was sent from God unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth...The angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou

hast found favor with God. And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shall call his name Jesus” (Luke 1:30–31).

15. **King Jesus.** [Note: This was spoken in a parable; however, all parables, which were given by King Jesus, were to be taken very seriously. This one relates to the future Millennium of King Jesus and how he will someday bring peace to earth by the process of eliminating his dedicated enemies who will not submit to his authority and power.]
16. **Isaiah 9:6.** “For unto us a child is born [King Jesus], unto us a son is given: and the government [of all nations] shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.”
17. **Revelation 20:6, which says,** “Blessed and holy *is* he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.”
18. **In the Bottomless Pit. Revelation 20:1–3 says,** “And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the Bottomless Pit and a great chain in his hand. And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, and cast him into the Bottomless Pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, until the thousand years [of peace on earth] should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.”
19. **Yes. Revelation 1:7 says,** “Behold, he [King Jesus] cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him...”
20. **No, the verse has no Bible prophecy reference to the future Great Tribulation events, as taught in the book of Rev-**

elation. I Thessalonians 5:9 teaches, “For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ.” **Also, King Jesus taught in Luke 21:36**, “Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape ALL THESE THINGS that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.”

21. **The Holy City, New Jerusalem. Revelation 3:12** says, “Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God [New Jerusalem], and he shall go no more out [for permanent living]: and I [King Jesus] will write upon him the name of my God [our Heavenly Father], and the name of THE CITY OF MY GOD, WHICH IS NEW JERUSALEM, which cometh down out of heaven from my God [to Earth]: and I will write upon him my [King Jesus’s] new name.”
22. **Yes, according to 2 Corinthians 5:8**, which says, “We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body [that we now have on Earth], and to be present with the Lord [where he presently resides, in the holy city, New Jerusalem].”
23. **No. According to John 11:26**, **no true Christian ever actually dies. Our bodies go to the grave to await a final resurrection wherein we will have glorified bodies united with our soul, which will never see death. All Christians presently have eternal life.** King Jesus stated, “And whosoever liveth and believeth in me [their soul] shall never die. Believest thou this?”
24. **No, God himself tells us more than once that he is the only true God in existence in the universe. In Isaiah 45:18**, **God says**, “I am the Lord; and there is none else [no other God in existence in the universe].”
25. **In Luke 21:36**, **King Jesus told us to**, “Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all

these things [during the Great Tribulation] that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man.”

26. **Yes. According to Daniel 9:24, the day will come on Earth when God will:** “...finish the transgression(s) [of wrongdoing on the earth] and make an end of sins, make reconciliation for iniquity, bring in everlasting righteousness, seal up the vision and prophecy and anoint the most holy [his only begotten son, King Jesus, the Prince of Peace]” (Daniel 9:24).
27. **White, as noted in Revelation 1:14, where John said,** “His [King Jesus’s] head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire; and his feet like unto fine brass.”
28. **No. According to 1 Thessalonians 4:13–18, we will go up “in the clouds, to meet” King Jesus.** “...we [Christians] which are alive and remain [on earth] shall be caught up together with them [those Christians in the grave who are raptured first] in the clouds, to meet the Lord [King Jesus] in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words.”
29. **A musical trumpet.** “For the Lord [King Jesus] himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump [trumpet] of God...”
30. **Michael, the “Great Prince” in heaven, as noted in Daniel 12:1,** “And at that time shall Michael [a heavenly archangel—Jude 1:9 and Revelation 12:7] stand up, the Great Prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble [seven years of Great Tribulation], such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time...”
31. **Yes, according to Daniel 12:1, which says,** “everyone that shall be found written in the book [Lamb’s Book of Life in heaven].”

32. **No, as promised by God in Revelation 3:10**, "...I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation [future Great Tribulation], which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth." **And, as promised by King Jesus in Luke 21:36**, "Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man."
33. **"In the twinkling of an eye," as taught in 1 Corinthians 15:51–52**, "...in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye..."
34. **Yes, as noted in Acts 3:21**, "And he [our Heavenly Father] shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began."
35. **Enoch and Elijah. Genesis 5:24 states**, "And Enoch walked [righteously] with God: and he was not [he was no longer found on Earth]; for God took him [raptured Enoch up to heaven]." **2 Kings 2:12 confirms**, "Elijah went up [was raptured] by a whirlwind into heaven. And Elisha saw it, and he cried, "My Father, my Father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof." And he [Elisha] saw him no more [on earth]."
36. **Twenty thousand heavenly chariots. Psalms 68:17 confirms**, "The chariots of God [in heaven] are twenty thousand, even [including] thousands of angels..."
37. **A man the Word of God calls the Antichrist or "son of perdition [or, evil deeds]."** **1 John 2:18 confirms**, "Little children, it is the last time [final days in the fulfillment of Bible prophecy]: and as ye have heard that [the] Antichrist shall come..." **2 Thessalonians 2:3 adds**, "...that man of sin [the Antichrist] be revealed, the son of perdition; who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God..."

- 38. Day of God's wrath and a day of God's vengeance. Revelation 6:17 states, "For the great day of his [God's] wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?" Zephaniah 2:15 says, "That day is a day of [God's] wrath..." Isaiah 61:2 says, "... the day of vengeance of our God..." Isaiah 63:4 says, "...For the day of vengeance is in mine heart..."; and, Jeremiah 46:10 says, "For this is the day of the Lord GOD of hosts, a day of vengeance, that he may avenge him of his adversaries..." (Other references: Romans 2:5; Isaiah 13:9; Isaiah 13:13; and, Ezekiel 7:19)**
- 39. Seven years (peace agreement) = "one week" in Hebrew biblical interpretation. Daniel 9:27 confirms, "And he [the Antichrist] shall confirm the covenant with many [Israel and the other nations] for one week..."**
- 40. After three and a half years, the peace agreement will be broken by the Antichrist. Daniel 9:27 confirms, "in the midst [or middle] of the week [seven years; middle of the seven years will be three and a half years] he [the Antichrist] shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease [in Israel's temple]."**
- 41. A total of twenty-eight Great Tribulation judgments and/or events: seven seals, seven trumpets, seven thunders, and seven vials [Note: God showed John what will happen in each of the seven thunders; however, John was not allowed by God to write down what God showed him.]**
- 42. In Israel, between the Mediterranean Sea and the Dead Sea will be the Antichrist's religious headquarters. Daniel 11:45 teaches, "And he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas [Mediterranean and Dead Sea] in the glorious holy mountain [Mount Moriah is the Temple Mount in Jerusalem]; yet he [the Antichrist] shall come to his end [later, at the Battle of Armageddon], and none [nobody on earth]**

shall help him.” **In the wealthy industrial City of Babylon will be the political headquarters of the Antichrist. Revelation 17: 18 says,** “And the woman which thou sawest is that great city [City of Babylon], which reigneth over the kings of the earth [under the authority of the Antichrist].”

43. **Yes, according to Revelation 6:9–11. John said,** “I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the Word of God [during the Great Tribulation], and for the testimony which they held...” [Note: Enoch and Elijah will be preaching God’s message of repentance from sin; 144,000 Jewish evangelists will be preaching a message of repentance from sin; and, heavenly angels in the air above earth will be preaching God’s message of repentance from sin.]
44. **Yes, according to the teaching of King Jesus in John 14:16, as stated,** “And I [King Jesus] will pray [to] the [Heavenly] Father, and he shall give you another Comforter [the Holy Spirit], that he may abide with you forever...” [Note: 2 Thessalonians 2:7 is a reference to the rapture of the church, which will be ‘taken out of the way’ prior to the revelation of the Antichrist and seven years of Great Tribulation. “For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he (King Jesus’s church) who now letteth (or, hinders, by prayer, the Antichrist, in making his earthly appearance) will let (allow, as directed by God) until he (King Jesus’s church) be taken out of the way (at the rapture).”]
45. **The Seven Thunder Judgments, as noted in Revelation 10:3–4, which says,** “Seven Thunders uttered their voices. And when the Seven Thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, seal up those things [details of all of the information] which the Seven Thunders uttered, and write them not.”

46. **God will allow the Antichrist to kill Enoch and Elijah, then after three and a half days with their bodies still in the street, both will be raptured by God to heaven. Revelation 11:11–12 teaches,** “And they [Enoch and Elijah] heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, come up hither [rapture to heaven]. And they ascended up [were raptured] to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies [those who laughed at their death] beheld them.”
47. **All Great Tribulation saints who are killed by the Antichrist government on Earth will receive “white robes” when they arrive in heaven according to Revelation 6:11,** which says, “And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellow servants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.”
48. **No, according to Acts 2:21,** “And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.”
49. **God does not give us an answer to this question. We can only speculate.**
50. **Revelation 9:11 gives us two names for the king of the Bottomless Pit, one in the Hebrew language, Abaddon; and one in the Greek language, Apollyon.** “And they had a king over them, which is the [demonic] angel of the Bottomless Pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath his name Apollyon.”
51. **Four demonic angels will be released from captivity in the Euphrates River according to Revelation 9:14,** “Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.”
52. **“Two hundred thousand, thousand,” according to Revelation 9:16, which is the same as two hundred million demonic**

- horse/lion creatures**—“And the number of the army of the horsemen *were* two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.”
- 53. Yes, as taught in the Holy Bible in 2 Thessalonians 1:6, which says,** “It is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you.”
- 54. Seven Thunder Judgments, as taught in Revelation 10:1–4,** “And when the Seven Thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, seal up those things which the Seven Thunders uttered, and write them not.”
- 55. Enoch and Elijah. Genesis 5:24 says,** “...and Enoch walked with God and God took him.” **2 Kings 2:11 states,** “...and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.”
- 56. Yes, according to Jude 1:14–15, which says,** “And Enoch also, the seventh [seven generations] from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints, to execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him [King Jesus].”
- 57. The two Bible prophets will preach for three and a half years according to Revelation 11:3, which says,** “And I will give *power* unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred *and* threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.”
- 58. God will allow the Antichrist and his government to kill the two prophets as stated in Revelation 11:7, which says,** “And when they [Enoch and Elijah] shall have finished their testimony, the beast [Antichrist] that ascendeth out of the Bottomless Pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.”

- 59. Yes, many on Earth will laugh and send gifts to one another to celebrate the deaths of the two Bible prophets according to Revelation 11:10–12, which says, “And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them [because they are dead], and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another...And after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them. And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, come up hither [another rapture to heaven]. And they ascended up [were raptured] to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies [those who laughed at their death] beheld them.”**
- 60. Yes, according to Revelation 11:18, which says, “And the nations were angry, and thy [God’s] wrath [or judgment] is come...that they should be judged...and [it is now the time that God] should destroy them which destroy the earth [with all of their sins and corruption].”**
- 61. Yes, according to Revelation 11:2, which says, “...for it is given unto the Gentiles [non-Jewish people]: and the holy city [Jerusalem] shall they tread under foot forty *and* two months.” [forty-two months = three and a half years]**
- 62. The Antichrist will use the promise of “peace” to deceive and kill many on earth, as noted in Daniel 8:25, which says, “...and by peace shall [the Antichrist] destroy many [on earth].”**
- 63. Revelation 13:16–17 teaches that people will have a choice of the “right hand” or, upon the “forehead.” “And he [false prophet] causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or on their foreheads...that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.”**

- 64. Yes, according to Revelation 14:2, which says,** “And I heard the voice of harpers harping with their [musical instrument] harps: And they sung as it were a new song before the throne [of God]” (14:2). Also, in Psalms 87:7: “As well the singers as the players on instruments shall be there: all my springs [of water] are in thee” (Psalm 87:7).
- 65. Yes, according to Revelation 14:6–7, which says,** “And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.” (see also, Revelation 14:9–10)
- 66. According to Revelation 16:16, they will go to “Armageddon” in Israel to initiate the Battle of Armageddon.** “And he gathered them [the three demonic spirits of devils] together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon.”
- 67. The end of the seven years of future Great Tribulation judgment/events from God, as taught in Revelation 16:18, which says,** “There were voices, and thunders, and lightning’s; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great.” [This is at the ending of the last seven Vial/Bowl Judgments, which God sends to earth.]
- 68. Yes, and it will be the City of Babylon as taught in Revelation 17:8, which says,** “And the woman which thou sawest is that great city [City of Babylon], which reigneth over the kings of the earth [under the authority of the Antichrist].”
- 69. One hour, according to Revelation 18:10–11, which says,** “Alas, alas that great city Babylon, that mighty city! For in one

hour is thy judgment come. And the merchants of the earth shall weep and mourn over her...”

70. **According to Revelation 17:12–13, ten powerful nations (“ten kings”) and the Antichrist will wage “war” on King Jesus and Israel (Battle of Armageddon) as stated,** “...ten kings... receive power as kings one hour with the beast [Antichrist]. These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast [Antichrist]. These shall make war [at the Battle of Armageddon] with the Lamb [King Jesus], and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful.”
71. **All “shall rejoice.” According to Psalms 58:10,** “The righteous shall rejoice when he sees the vengeance [of God]: he shall wash his feet in the blood of the wicked [on earth].”
72. **Yes, as taught in Revelation 19:7 and 19:9, which says,** “Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honor to him [King Jesus]: for the Marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife [the church] hath made herself ready. And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed *are* they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.” [King Jesus will be the groom in this marriage and the church will be the bride-of-Christ.]
73. **Yes, according to John 3:35 where King Jesus states,** “The [Heavenly] Father loveth the Son [King Jesus], and hath given all things into his hand.”
74. **Yes, according to Revelation 19:11, 14, which says,** “... and the armies which were in heaven followed him [King Jesus] upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean” (Revelation 19:11, 14).
75. **Yes, as shown in Isaiah 35:10 and 51:11, which says,** “And the ransomed [those redeemed] of the Lord shall return [to

earth], and come to Zion [Jerusalem] with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.”

- 76. King Jesus’s Millennial Temple will be in the “midst” of Israel “forevermore” according to Ezekiel 37:28, which says, “And the heathen [on earth] shall know that I the Lord do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary [temple] shall be in the midst of them [Israel] forevermore.”**
- 77. Yes, King Jesus will someday, at the Battle of Armageddon, have warfare with the Antichrist and all “nations” that will someday try to destroy Israel, as taught in Zechariah 14:3, which says, “Then shall the Lord [King Jesus] go forth, and fight against those nations.” [This will be the second coming of King Jesus to earth.]**
- 78. The Mount of Olives, as taught in Zechariah 14:4, which says, “And his [King Jesus’s] feet shall stand in that day upon the Mount of Olives...” [Where King Jesus gave the “Ser- mon on the Mount”; and, the location of the Garden of Gethsemane, where King Jesus prayed, prior to his crucifixion.]**
- 79. Yes, according to Zechariah 14:5, 9, which says, “And the Lord my God [King Jesus] shall come, and all the [heavenly] saints. And the Lord [King Jesus] shall be king over all the earth.”**
- 80. Yes, according to Psalms 97:3–5, which says, “A fire goeth before him [King Jesus], and burneth up his enemies round about. His lightnings enlightened the world: the [people of] earth saw, and trembled. The hills melted like wax at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth.”**
- 81. Seven months according to Ezekiel 39:12, which says, “And seven months shall the house of Israel be burying of them, that they may cleanse the land.”**

- 82. The words “King of Kings and Lord of Lords” will be written, as taught in Revelation 19:16, which says, “And he [King Jesus] hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.”**
- 83. Yes, according to Psalms 68:17 and Isaiah 66:15–16, which says, “The chariots of God [our Heavenly Father] are twenty thousand, even thousands of angels: the Lord [King Jesus] is among them, as in Sinai, in the holy place.” “For, behold, the Lord [our Heavenly Father] will come with fire, and with his [twenty thousand] chariots like a whirlwind, to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire. For by fire and by his sword will the Lord plead with all flesh: and the slain of the Lord shall be many.”**
- 84. The Heavenly Father travels on a “Cherub” according to Psalms 18:10 and 2 Samuel 22:11, which state, “And he rode upon a cherub [angelic being], and did fly: yea, he did fly upon the wings of the wind.” “And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: and he was seen upon the wings of the wind.”**
- 85. King Jesus will send them to “a Lake of Fire” according to Revelation 19:20, which says, “These both were cast alive into a Lake of Fire burning with brimstone.”(a thousand years later: Revelation 20:10, “And the devil that deceived them was cast into the Lake of Fire and brimstone, where the beast [Antichrist] and the false prophet *are*, and shall be tormented day and night forever and ever.”)**
- 86. The military equipment will be melted down and made into farming equipment according to Isaiah 2:4 and Micah 4:3, which says, “...and they [all nations] shall beat [mold or convert] their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn [study the tactics of] war anymore.”**

87. **King David, as stated in Psalms 47:2, which teaches King Jesus will be** "...a great king over all the earth. He shall subdue the people under us, and the nations [on earth] under our feet."
88. **One-sixth of the military will be allowed to live, according to Ezekiel 39:2, where God says,** "And I will turn thee [the army of the Antichrist] back [at the Battle of Armageddon], and leave but the sixth part of thee."
89. **Yes, according to Jeremiah 23:19–20, which says,** "Behold, a whirlwind of the Lord is gone forth in fury, even a grievous whirlwind: it shall fall grievously upon the head of the wicked. The anger of the Lord shall not return, until he has executed, and until he has performed the thoughts of his heart: **in the latter days ye shall consider [understand] it perfectly.**" [Also, read Jeremiah 25:31–33]
90. **King Jesus will "sit to judge all the heathen" at the "Valley of Jehoshaphat" in Israel following the future Battle of Armageddon at the Judgment of the Nations, as taught in Joel 3:12, which says,** "Let the heathen be wakened, and come up to the Valley of Jehoshaphat: for there will I [King Jesus] sit to judge all the heathen round about."
91. **King Jesus will accomplish his mission in "one day" according to Zechariah 3:9, which says,** "...and I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day."
92. **Yes, at his second coming to earth, King Jesus will come in the "clouds" and "every eye shall see him" according to Revelation 1:7, which says,** "Behold, he [King Jesus] cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him."
93. **Iron, according to Revelation 2:27, which says,** "And he [King Jesus] shall rule them [the nations] with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father."

- 94. Zacharias, father of John the Baptist, as noted in Luke 1:79.**
God told Zacharias that Jesus will someday "...guide our feet into the way of peace."
- 95. In Luke 2:13–14, the heavenly "multitude" announced, "...**
on earth peace, good will toward men. And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men."
- 96. Isaiah, as noted in Isaiah 29:23–24, which says, "They also**
that erred [were wrong] in spirit shall come to understanding [the truth and what is right], and they that murmured [complained or disapproved] shall learn doctrine."
- 97. Forever, as taught to the Prophet Ezekiel in Ezekiel 37:26–**
28, where God says, "Moreover I will make a covenant of
peace with them [Israel]; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary [King Jesus' Millennial Temple] in the midst of them forevermore. My tabernacle [the New Jerusalem in Revelation chapter 21] also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people. And the heathen [unconverted] shall know that I the Lord do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them forevermore."
- 98. King Jesus Himself will direct the building of His future**
Millennial Temple as taught in Zechariah 6:13, which says,
"Even he [King Jesus] shall build the temple of the Lord; and he shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon his throne; and he shall be a priest upon his throne: and the counsel of peace shall be between them both [King Jesus and Israel]."
- 99. No, Israel will not be the only blessed nation on earth**
because of God's covenant with Abraham, "all nations...of
faith" in God will be "blessed" as taught in Galatians 3:8–9,

which says, “And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen [Gentiles] through faith, preached before the Gospel unto Abraham, saying, in thee [Abraham/Israel] shall all nations be blessed. So then they [non-Jews] which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham.” (also, note Ephesians 3:6).

100. “Earth”: “peace.”

101. No, there will by no “sick” or afflicted individuals in Jerusalem, Israel, as taught in Isaiah 29:18 and 33:24, which says, “And in that day shall the deaf hear the words of the book [God’s Word], and the eyes of the blind shall see out of obscurity, and out of darkness. And the inhabitant [of Jerusalem] shall not say, ‘I am sick’: the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their iniquity.”

102. As taught in Proverbs 13:13, “Whoso despiseth the word [God’s law] shall be destroyed.”

103. Yes, all people on earth in all nations will be required to “bow” in respect and obey the millennial laws of King Jesus according to Romans 14:11, which says, “For it is written, as I live, saith the Lord, every knee [on earth] shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to [acknowledge] God.”

104. Yes, King Jesus will assist the “poor and needy” as He governs all nations on earth for one thousand years, as taught in Isaiah 41:17, which says, “When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, and their tongue faileth for thirst, I the Lord will hear them, I the God of Israel will not forsake them.”

105. God’s covenant with King David was called the “Covenant of Salt,” as taught in Second Chronicles 13:5, which says, “Ought ye not to know that the Lord God of Israel gave the kingdom over Israel to David forever, even to him and to his sons by a covenant of salt?”

- 106. Yes, King David will be king over all of Israel for one thousand years during the future Millennium of King Jesus; and, “forever,” as taught in Ezekiel 37:24–25, where God says, “And David my servant shall be king over them [Israel]; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes [laws], and do them... and my servant David shall be their prince forever.” [Also, Hosea 3:5]**
- 107. “Feet”** [reference to the future Millennium of King Jesus]
- 108. Acts 3:23 confirms,** “And it shall come to pass, that every soul, which will not hear [obey] that prophet [King Jesus], shall be destroyed from among the people.”
- 109. According to Isaiah 9:6–7,** “Of the increase of his [King Jesus’s] government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even forever. The zeal of the Lord of Hosts will perform this.”
- 110. Yes, all who honor and worship King Jesus will have “plenty” to eat, as noted in Joel 2:26–27, which says,** “And ye shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the name of the Lord your God, that hath dealt wondrously with you: and my people shall never be ashamed. And ye shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am the Lord your God, and none else: and my people shall never be ashamed.”
- 111. Yes, the sun will provide seven times more light than it now sends to earth, and the moon will send out as much light as the sun presently sends to earth. Isaiah 30:26 says,** “Moreover the light of the moon shall be as the light of the sun, and the light of the sun shall be sevenfold, as the light of seven days, in the day that the Lord [King Jesus] bindeth up the breach of his people [Israel], and healeth the stroke of their wound.”

- 112. No, Israel will have no need to “borrow” anything from any of the nations on earth, as taught in Deuteronomy 28:12–13, which says, “...and thou [Israel] shall lend unto many nations, and thou shall not borrow. And the Lord shall make thee the head [of all nations], and not the tail.” [The Prophet Isaiah adds, “Israel shall blossom and bud, and fill the face of the world with fruit.” (Isaiah 27:6)]**
- 113. Yes, to both questions, as shown in Ezekiel 43:2, which says, “And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel [King Jesus] came from the way of the east: and his voice was like a noise of many waters: and the earth shined with his glory” (Ezekiel 43:2). [Also, as stated in Psalms 72:19, “And blessed be his glorious name forever: and let the whole earth be filled with his glory; amen, and amen.” [Also, in Numbers 14:21, God said, “But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the Lord.”]**
- 114. The last nine chapters of Ezekiel do not mention any western wall.**
- 115. The Eastern Gate of the Millennial Temple courtyard is for King Jesus only. Ezekiel 44:1–3 teaches, “...the gate of the outward sanctuary [temple] which looketh toward the east... This gate shall be shut, it shall not be opened, and no man shall enter in by it; because the Lord, the God of Israel [King Jesus], hath entered in by it...” [Note: a door by the eastern gate will only be used by the “prince” of Israel, who will sometimes accompany King Jesus]**
- 116. Yes, during the future Millennium of King Jesus. Isaiah 61:11 confirms, “...the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations” on the earth.**
- 117. Yes, as verified in Isaiah 10:17 and 55:13, which says, “And the light of Israel shall be for [like] a fire, and his Holy One**

[King Jesus] for a flame: and it [the fire] shall burn and devour his thorns and his briers in one day.”

118. The Prophet Isaiah, as noted in Isaiah 40:31.

119. King Jesus made the statement in his Sermon on the Mount—Luke 6:20–21.

120. “Straw,” as noted in Isaiah 11:7 “...the lion shall eat straw like the ox.” [also found in Isaiah 65:25]

121. All will be riding heavenly white horses as noted in Revelation 19:11 and 19:14, which says, “And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him [King Jesus] was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war [on earth]... And the armies which were in heaven followed him [King Jesus] upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.”

122. King Jesus himself will officiate in the building of his future Millennial Temple, as taught in Zechariah 6:12–13, “The Branch [King Jesus]; and he shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the temple [Millennial Temple] of the Lord: even he shall build the temple of the Lord; and he shall bear the glory, and [King Jesus] shall sit and rule upon his throne; and he shall be a priest upon his throne: and the counsel of peace shall be between them both.”

123. King David saw twenty thousand heavenly chariots, as noted in Psalms 68:17, which says, “The chariots of God [our Heavenly Father] are twenty thousand, even thousands of angels: the Lord is among them, as in Sinai, in the holy place.”

124. Satan himself, as taught in Ephesians 2:2, which says, “... according to the prince of the power of the air [Satan], the spirit that now works in the children of disobedience.”

125. As shown in Revelation 12:9–10, “The great dragon” is “that old serpent, called the devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the

whole world: he was cast out [of heaven] into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.”

- 126. An angel of God will “cast” Satan into the Bottomless Pit, where he will remain for a thousand years, as noted in Revelation 20:1–3, which says,** “And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the Bottomless Pit and a great chain in his hand. And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, and cast him into the Bottomless Pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, until the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he [Satan] must be loosed a little season.”
- 127. Earth’s final war is known as the Battle of Gog and Magog, as noted in Revelation 20:7–10, which says,** “And when the thousand years [Millennium of King Jesus] is expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, and [Satan] shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog, and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom [will join Satan’s army] is as the sand of the sea.”
- 128. Satan will be cast into the Lake of Fire and Brimstone where the beast [Antichrist] and false prophet are, as taught in Revelation 20:10, which says,** “And the devil that deceived them was cast into the Lake of Fire and Brimstone, where the beast [Antichrist] and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night forever and ever.”
- 129. Yes, all sinners who do not have their names in heaven’s Lamb’s Book of Life will have a final judgment at God’s Great White Throne in heaven in the future as taught in Revelation 20:11–15, which says,** “And I [John] saw a Great White Throne [in heaven], and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found

no place for them [those in heaven that were around God's throne]. And I saw the dead, small, and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the Book of Life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works."

130. God has an "innumerable company of angels" living in his holy city, New New Jerusalem, which is now in heaven, as noted in Hebrews 12:22, which says, "But ye are come unto Mount Zion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem [New Jerusalem], and to an innumerable company of angels."

131. Yes, according to Hebrews 11:10, "...he [Abraham] looked for a city [New Jerusalem] which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God." [This is a description of the holy city, New Jerusalem in the book of Revelation, chapters 21 and 22]

132. As taught by King Jesus in Matthew 22:30, there will be no marriages for those who will forever be living in the Holy City, New Jerusalem. King Jesus said, "For in the resurrection [New Jerusalem] they neither marry, nor are given in marriage [to one another], but are as the angels of God in heaven."

133. Yes, according to Revelation 21:9–13, which says, "...one of the seven angels...talked with me, saying, come hither, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife. And he [the angel] carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the Holy Jerusalem, descending [or, departing] out of heaven from God, having the glory of God."

134. Yes, as confirmed in Revelation 21:12, which says, "And [the New Jerusalem] had a wall great and high and had twelve gates [of pearls], and at the gates twelve angels [of God], and

names written on the [pearl] gates, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel...”

- 135. The foursquare wall of the New Jerusalem will have twelve beautiful gemstone foundations, as noted in Revelation 21:14, which says, “And the wall of the city [of New Jerusalem] had twelve foundations, and in [written on] them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb [King Jesus, Son of God].”**
- 136. The wall of the New Jerusalem will be 216 feet wide and 1,500 miles tall, as verified in Revelation 21:14–17, which says, “And he [the angel] measured the wall thereof, an hundred and forty and four [144] cubits [wide, which is 216 feet], according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.” And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand [12,000] furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.”**
- 137. As promised by God in Revelation 21:18–20, “And the building of the [upper] wall [of the holy city, New Jerusalem] of it was of **jasper**: and the city was pure gold [for the inside construction], like unto clear glass. And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious [gem] stones. The first foundation was **jasper**; the second, **sapphire**; the third, a **chalcedony**; the fourth, an **emerald**; the fifth, **sardonyx**; the sixth, **sardius**; the seventh, **chrysolite**; the eighth, **beryl**; the ninth, twelfth, an **amethyst**.”**
- 138. No, the New Jerusalem’s twelve gates of pearl will never be “shut” and there will never be any darkness (night time), as noted in Revelation 21:25, which says, “...and the gates [of pearls] of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there.”**

- 139. As taught in Revelation 21:3 and 21:24**, “And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle [temple] of God *is* with men [on earth], and he will dwell with them [on earth], and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God...the kings of the earth [in all nations on earth] do bring their glory and honor into it [the holy City of New Jerusalem].” (Those who live on the outside of the holy city, New Jerusalem, will be allowed to visit the inside of the city.)
- 140. Revelation 3:12 teaches**, “Him that overcometh will I make a pillar [supportive ambassador] in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out [will not have to live outside of the New Jerusalem].
- 141. Revelation 3:12 confirms what three things will be literally written on the bodies of those Christians/saints living inside the Holy City, New Jerusalem. God said**, “and I will write upon him [or, her] (1) **the name of my God** [our Heavenly Father], and (2) **the name of the City of my God**, which is New Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God [to be on earth]: and (3) **I will write upon him my new name** [King Jesus’s new name].”
- 142. God promises in Revelation 21:1–4 that he** “...shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.”
- 143. King Jesus will be our “everlasting light” in the Holy City, New Jerusalem, as taught in Isaiah 60:19–22**: “The sun shall be no more thy [Israel’s] light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee: but the Lord [King Jesus] shall be unto thee [Israel] an everlasting light, and thy God thy glory. Thy sun shall no more go down [there will be continual

light]; neither shall thy moon withdraw itself: for the Lord shall be thine everlasting light, and the days of thy mourning shall be ended.”

144. The “curse,” which God announced to Adam and Eve, will be completely removed when God himself brings the holy City of New Jerusalem down from heaven and places it on the earth, where it will abide forever, as taught in Revelation 22:3–4, which says, “And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God [Heavenly Father] and of the Lamb [King Jesus] shall be in it [the New Jerusalem]; and his [God’s] servants shall serve him: and they shall see his face; and his [God’s] name shall be in their foreheads.”

145. Yes, according to Revelation 22:5, God confirms, “and they [those living in the Holy City of New Jerusalem] shall reign forever and ever [over earthly nations].”

146. Yes, all women living in the nations outside of the New Jerusalem will have no “pain, sorrow, tears, death, [or] crying” when giving birth to children. God promises in Revelation 21:1–4 that he “...shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.”

147. Following are some of the things that King Jesus, Apostle John, and our Heavenly Father revealed, which related to the interior of the holy City of New Jerusalem, our future everlasting home:

- “City of Gold”
- Streets of “gold”
- “River of Life”
- “Trees of Life, with fruit”

- “Throne of God”
- “Mansions”
- “Sea of Glass”
- “Innumerable Angels”
- “Seraphim” angelic beings
- “Cherubim” angelic beings
- “Everlasting Light”
- Heavenly “Saints”
- “Lamb’s Book of Life”
- Our “Heavenly Father”
- King “Jesus,” Son of God
- “the Glory of God”
- “24 Elders” around God’s throne wearing “Crowns of Gold”
- Musical “harps” around God’s throne
- “Golden Vials, Prayers of the Saints”
- Singing and music
- Continual worship of God
- “Rainbow” around the “Throne of God”
- “Lightning, Thunder, Voices” around the “Throne of God”
- “Seven Lamps” around the “Throne of God”
- “White Stones”
- “Hidden Manna”
- “White Raiment” or clothing on all saints
- God’s record “books” for records of activity on earth
- And, we shall meet all of those who we have read about in the Holy Bible in the holy City of New Jerusalem, home-sweet-home forever.

148. No, every day in the holy City of New Jerusalem will be a wonderful and exciting day—forever, as we live in the “house” of our Heavenly Father, the holy City of New Jeru-

saalem. Psalms 16:11 confirms, “Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence *is* fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.”

149. Yes, as taught in 2 Peter 3:9, “The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish [die without forgiveness of sin], but that all should come to repentance.” **And in First John 1:9, God promises**, “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.” **All who truly repent and ask God for forgiveness of sin; and accept Jesus Christ, Son of God, as Lord and Savior, will have their everlasting inheritance in the holy City of New Jerusalem.**

150. In Matthew 22:36–40, King Jesus tells the greatest things that we as true Christians can do to totally please God: “Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.”
